What is sin? In the Bible, sin is broken up into three different categories. Here are the literal definitions from the original Hebrew language that the Old Testament was written in.

1. SIN / *Chatta'ah*: an offence, sometimes habitual.
2. TRANSGRESSION / *Ma'al*: a falsehood, trespass, sin..
3. INIQUITY/*Avon*: a perversity or moral evil.

These are the Ten Comandments, according to Exodus 20:3-17.

1. "You shall have no other gods before Me."
2. "You shall not make for yourself a carved image... You shall not bow down to them. nor serve them."
3. "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain."
4. "Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy."
5. "Honor your father and mother."
6. "You shall not murder."
7. "You shall not commit adultery"
8. "You shall not steal."
9. "You shall not bear false witness." (lie)
10. "You shall not covet..." (want what is not yours)

James 2:10 says "For whoever shall keep the whole law, and stumble in one point, he is guilty of all."
